Academic Excellence

Academic excellence remains the hallmark of Mount Litera Zee School. In the **CBSE Board Examinations 2025**, our students once again upheld the tradition of outstanding performance.

- **Class X achieved a 100% pass percentage**, with many students securing distinctions and scoring above 90% in aggregate.
- **Class XII results were equally commendable** across Science, Commerce and Humanities streams, with the **highest aggregate reaching 96%**.
- Several students earned **subject topper positions**, reflecting their dedication and the constant support of our teachers.

These achievements are a testament to the commitment of our faculty, whose innovative teaching practices and personal mentoring help students reach their highest potential.

SOF and Olympiad Achievements

Our students also excelled in national-level academic competitions. In the **Science Olympiad Foundation (SOF) examinations**, students participated in **English, Science, Mathematics and Cyber Olympiads**.

- Many students secured **Gold, Silver and Bronze medals at the school level**.
- Several students **qualified for Level II Olympiads**, bringing pride to the school community.

These accomplishments highlight the school's focus on encouraging analytical thinking, curiosity and academic excellence beyond the classroom.

Inter-School Achievements
